**Approval of Meeting Agenda and January 2026 Minutes:**

Chair Schulte called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. Kuhlman moved to accept the January 2026 minutes, which Klich seconded. The meeting agenda, as updated, was approved in a motion by Klich, seconded by Lawson.

**Treasurer's Report for January 2026:**

Griggs reported on annual financial activity: Checking balance - \$2,430.37  
Savings balance - \$11,119.29  
Brookshires Gift Card - \$132.44

**Library Liaison**

No report from Library Liaison.

Eshenour sent a report on the Library staff's recommendations regarding monthly purchases, and Schulte reported on book club purchases. Kuhlman made a motion to support the library's request for how to disperse the allotted \$200 per month: \$100 per month for fiction, purchase of 2 non-fiction, with any remaining funds of the allotted \$200 to be spent at the Lead Librarian's discretion for items such as completing a series, a patron request, or additional new release. The motion was seconded by Griggs and unanimously approved. Regarding FOCCL purchase of Book Club requests, Klich moved that FOCCL spend up to \$500 annually to purchase titles requested by HSV Book Clubs, at the discretion of the Lead Librarian, seconded by Lawson, and unanimously approved.

**Trivia Night:**

Schulte gave an update on our March 17 Trivia Night, which she is co-chairing with Kuhlman. The question committee has completed the game, and producer OBrien is preparing the deck. Kuhlman reported she is working cooperatively with the treasurer, Griggs, to receive registrations and contact teams. Trivia Night Team is meeting on Monday, February 23rd. Folders will be assembled on Monday, one day before the event. Board members are asked to submit the gift cards/door prizes for preparation by Dern.

**Woodlands Movie Night:**

"Movie Nights" continue in February. Klich reported low attendance. She is in charge of FOCCL volunteers for these, as they are an opportunity to collaborate with P&R and publicize FOCCL.

**New Business:**

Wine & Cheese author events will be held on June 23 and November 10, 2026. Welle will be the committee chair with support from Kuhlman. Welle has indicated she believes this book would be of interest to patrons.
